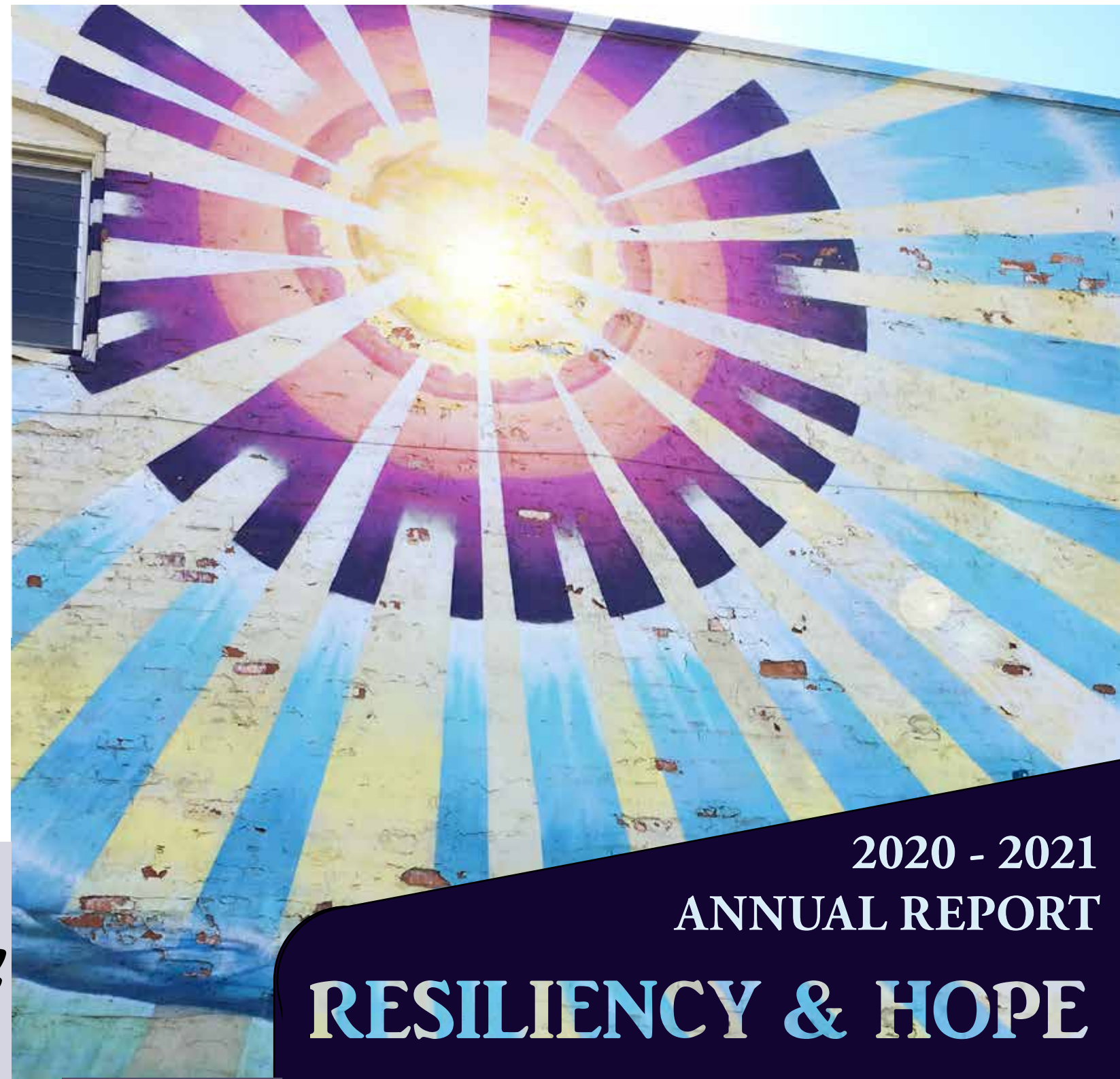

EMERGENCY NEEDS



Over 4,800 hot meals were served at our weekly soup kitchen ministry at St. Paul's on W. 16th Street and more than 600 walk-ins were provided with emergency needs such as food, hygiene and cleaning supplies, diapers, sheets and blankets. Each neighbor was also provided with referral to community agencies which address underlying needs such as inadequate employment, unstable housing, physical and mental healthcare.



IMPROVED PHYSICAL ATTRIBUTES



Renowned woodcarver Fredy Huaman Mallqui created an art piece out of a damaged tree at the farmers market lot along W. 18th Street. Additional elements were installed at Three Sisters Park on W. 19th St. and many residents and volunteers completed neighborhood clean-up activities throughout the year.



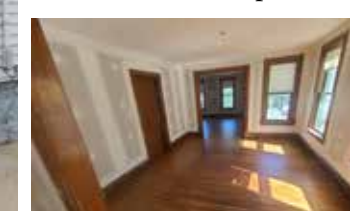
HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES



10 adults and 9 children were provided affordable housing this year and more units will soon be available.

5 homeowners and 3 landlords received grants for façade improvements or home repairs. One family "graduated" from the Genesis program and purchased their first home in the neighborhood.

In addition, due to a partnership with Maleno Builders an additional home was able to be improved.



ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT



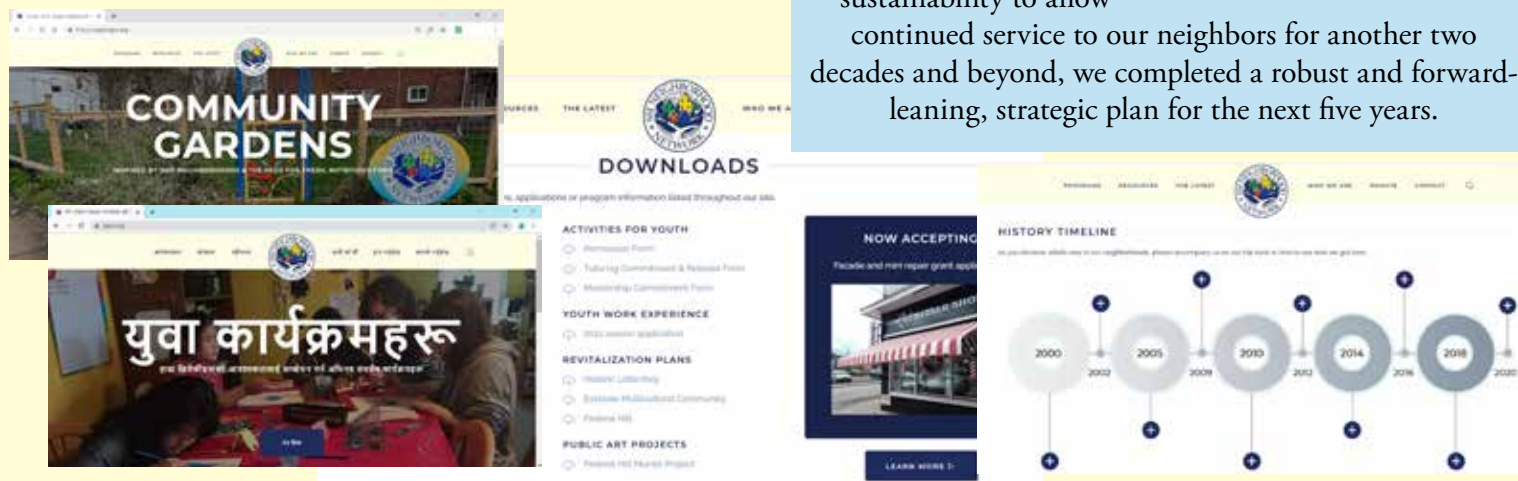
6 businesses received facade grants. We employed 13 neighborhood teens for highly supported work experiences. 185 bikes were donated, 95 bikes were given away, and volunteers provided many hours of service including 20 bike repair sessions and 14 training sessions. Bike outings were held with neighbors, as well as other community engagement events at the farmers market and more. Surveillance equipment was installed at 5 locations identified as area hot spots.

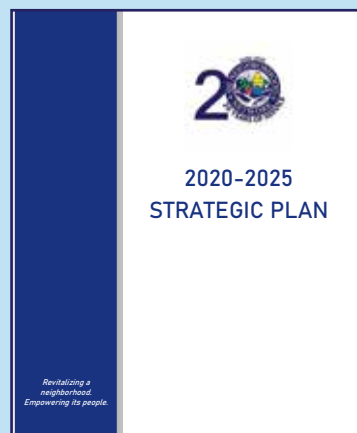

STRATEGIC PLAN

Our 20th Anniversary provided the perfect opportunity to step back and take stock of where we've been. What would things look like if the Sisters *didn't* start their neighborhood work 20 years ago?

With an eye toward sustainability to allow continued service to our neighbors for another two decades and beyond, we completed a robust and forward-leaning, strategic plan for the next five years.



YOUTH PROGRAMS



Many youth participated in tutoring or other activities, all amazingly and creatively delivered, such as outdoors, online or via packages (such as these Easter baskets) dropped at their homes. Youth also were graciously sponsored by a donor and attended Camp Notre Dame.



COMMUNITY GARDENS & FARMERS MARKET



Community gardens, an urban farm and orchards provided more than 60 families with opportunity to grow their own produce. More than 4,000 attended the Little Italy Farmers Market with our teens and 12 regional farmers. More than \$8,000 in match was graciously provided for patrons shopping with SNAP, WIC & FMNP senior vouchers, giving equity, choice and a far reach for fresh, life-giving, healthy food.

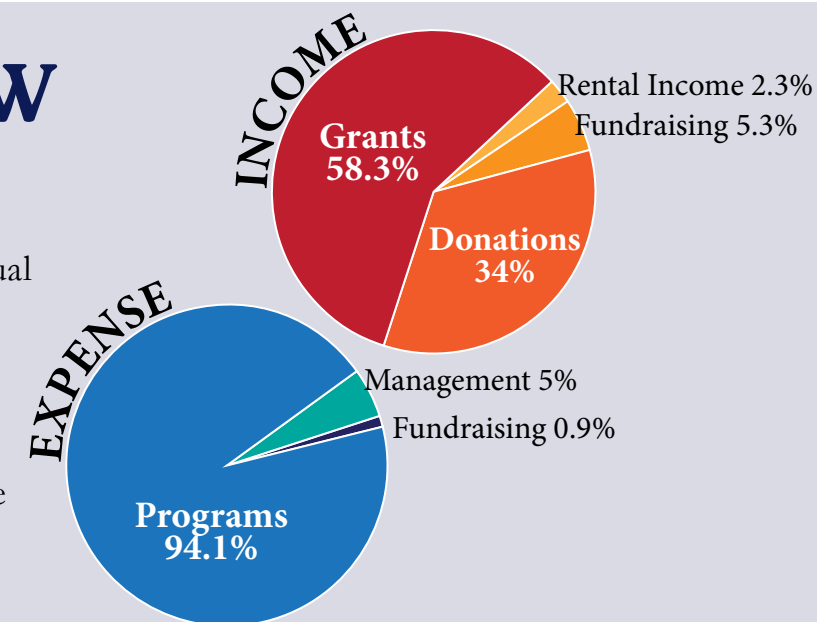
